Mystery Fellowship Dinners

- The purpose of Mystery Fellowship Dinners is to encourage all post-high school age CRPC adults to gather in small groups to get to know one another better and to have fellowship together while sharing a meal. These dinners are not restricted to married couples; singles are encouraged to sign up (as individuals or pairs).
- Dinners will be scheduled every other month, with two dates to choose from each time. You may participate as many or as few times as you prefer and are able during the year.
- When you sign up, you will list your preferences regarding the date, the food you would like to bring, or if you would prefer to host a dinner.
- The host will know who the dinner guests are and what course is assigned to everyone, so that they may remind each guest of the dinner location, time, etc. Guests know who their hosts are and what part of the meal they will be providing; the other food and guests are part of the mystery.
- These dinners do not need to be formal, and you do not need to have a large dining area to host a dinner. You may choose to have guests sit informally with plates on their laps, or perhaps dine on a porch or deck.
- Two couples with young children may pair together to participate in the dinners. On Friday evening, one couple will attend a dinner while the other couple cares for the children of both families. On Saturday, the couples switch places. In the same manner, CRPC couples or singles who do not have young children of their own, as a ministry to younger parents, may choose to pair up with a couple who needs a babysitter. If you will be pairing with someone else, please list their name in the space provided. They will also need to fill out a form.
